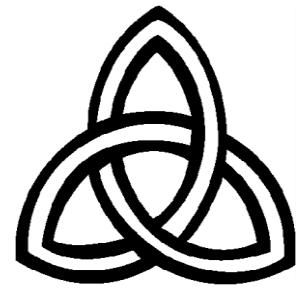

The Maji Project

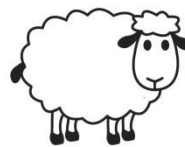
