COVID 19 Policy Statement

The churches of the Ballisodare Group of Parishes are committed to providing a safe and healthy workplace for all our volunteers and parishioners. To ensure that, we have developed the following COVID-19 Response Plan. All are responsible for the implementation of this plan and a combined effort will help contain the spread of the virus.

We will:

- continue to monitor our COVID-19 response and amend this plan in consultation with our volunteers and parishioners.
- provide up to date information to our volunteers and parishioners on the Public Health advice issued by the relevant authorities.
- display information on the signs and symptoms of COVID-19
- inform all volunteers and parishioners of essential hygiene and respiratory etiquette and physical distancing requirements.
- adapt the worship space to facilitate physical distancing.
- keep a log of contact / group work to help with contact tracing.
- have all key volunteers attend an induction / familiarisation / briefing.
- develop a procedure to be followed in the event of someone showing symptoms of COVID-19 while at work or in the workplace.
- provide instructions for volunteers and parishioners to follow if they develop signs and symptoms of COVID-19 during work
- intensify cleaning in line with government advice as required.

All parishioners will be consulted on an ongoing basis and feedback is encouraged on any concerns, issues or suggestions.
