

Assessment of Harm for Parish of Holy Trinity, Ballisodare

This assessment considers the potential for harm as defined by the Children Firsts Act to come to children whilst they are in Holy Trinity, Ballisodare care. This assessment must be done before the Child Safeguarding Statement (Section 11 (1b) Children First Act 2015) is published locally. In accordance with the requirements of *Section 11 (1) of the Children First Act 2015* the risk is of abuse and is not general health and safety risk. "Harm" in this context means, (a) assault, ill-treatment or neglect of the child in a manner that seriously affects or is likely to seriously affect the child's health, development or welfare, or (b) sexual abuse of the child, whether caused by a single act, omission or circumstance or a series or combination of acts, omissions or circumstances, or otherwise.

- Further action... indicates further action that might be necessary to alleviate any on-going risk.
